Hunter Education Field Day Requirements for HUNTERcourse.com New Jersey Students

All students must complete the HUNTERcourse.com Online Course and have a valid Field Day Voucher in order to gain admission to the Field Day.

Students who attempt to attend a course without the Field Day Voucher will not be allowed into the testing facility

Students must be at least 10 years of age before enrolling into firearm, or bow and arrow course.

Students with special needs, due to disabilities (learning or physical), must notify the office AFTER registering so that proper attention can be given to each student. The hunter education phone number can be found in the NJ Fish and Wildlife Digest

The Field Day

Once you have completed the HUNTERcourse.com online course, you are encouraged to practice with your firearm or bow. When you are ready, enrol in a Field Day online at <u>www.nj.wildlifelicense.com</u>.

Students must show up at the scheduled time printed on their NJ Division of Fish and Wildlife Confirmation page. Students who arrive late or without a Field Day will not be allowed into the course.

Be prepared to be at the testing facility for at least a 4-hour period depending on the number of disciplines you choose to complete.

You must bring the following materials to the Field Day:

Firearm Students:

Bring a cased shotgun (if you do not have one, one will be provided to you) Do NOT bring ammunition Bring eye and ear protection Bring a pencil Dress for the outdoors (the field session includes at least 2 hours outdoors, rain or shine)

Archery Students: You must have your own equipment!

Note that archery students can qualify for a crossbow. The crossbow must have a minimum draw weight of 75 lbs and a minimum stock length of 25 inches.

Students must be able to consistently place at least 3 out of 5 arrows into the vital area of a deer target placed at a distance between 10 and 20 yards. Practice!!!! Practice!!!! Practice!!!!

- Bring a bow with a minimum draw weight of 35 lbs. (or a crossbow as listed above)
- Bring 5 matched arrows with field points (no broadheads)

Bring a pencil

Dress for the outdoors (the field session includes at least 2 hours outdoors, rain or shine) Bring a rest for range shooting if using a crossbow (if needed)
